#### Rules

- 1. The Burmese Cat Club online show is open to any cat. You do not need to be a member of the club to enter, but you will need to be the current owner of the cat/kitten. The only exception to this is rule 2b.
- 2 a) You can enter the show as many times as you like, with as many cats as you like, although each cat may enter any class just ONCE. b) Kitten photos of adult cats are allowed, but you must have been the owner/breeder of the kitten at the time the photo was taken. c) There are special conditions for the Group entry class. Please see rule No. 9.
- 3. If you have a Burmese which you wish to enter into one of the ten colour classes (just the same as a live show) then you will need to submit the following. We will need TWO or THREE photos, at least one of a sideways headshot to show the cat's profile, and one full body shot. For all other classes 11-19 inclusive we will only need ONE photo. No Photoshopped or enhanced photos are allowed.
- 4. ALL photos for any class in the show need to be labelled with the following upon submission. Only the pet name of your cat and its age, followed by its sex (M=male, F=female, MN=male neuter, FN= female neuter). Kittens are counted as kittens up to and including 9 months of age. If an adult/neutered cat is a rescue cat, their approximate age in years will suffice.
- 5. The Burmese Cat Club Online Show is being run on Facebook where it has a dedicated page. There are three ways to enter. If you are a member of Facebook, simply follow the link on the BCC Club page. Or you can follow the link on our club website page www.burmesecatclub.com. Or you can send your photo(s) direct to Carole Kemp via email at catwoman444@msn.com. Or if you wish to enter by post you can send it to Carol Walker 11 St Saviours Close, Bamber Bridge, Preston, PR5 6AH. (We are sorry, but we can not return any posted photos.) If you are submitting your entry by email or post, please make sure you list the appropriate class(es) you wish to enter, and give your phone number. We are sorry but we cannot take responsibility for undelivered postal items or emails.
- 6. Once you have entered your class/es if you see any comments beneath the photo regarding the entry made by administrator please follow their instructions. e.g. you may have forgotten to give the sex or age of your cat or entered under their given pedigree name. Your entry will be disqualified if the additional information/change of name is not corrected by the time the show closes.
- 7. The show will run for 8 days.
- 8. Please read the class descriptions and make sure that you enter your cat in the correct class/es. If you are unsure of the colour of your Burmese, please contact Carolyn Kempe for assistance via email at kempe.oakenshield@gmail.com.
- 9. Group Entries. Multiple group photos featuring ALL the same cats are NOT permitted, but an overlap of one cat between 2 photos are allowed.
- 10. The Judges decisions are final. Judges may enter a class that they are not judging since no correspondence between judges will be entered into.
- 11. No professional photos or photos with watermarks are allowed.
- 12. Cats at Rainbow Bridge are NOT permitted to enter classes 1 to 10 inclusive, this is because the first prize being offered may need an additional photo of the winning entry for the front cover, which wouldn't be possible for these cats.
- 13. Please no photos of cats or kittens sitting inside household appliances. These will be automatically disqualified.
- 14. If you would like to sponsor a class/es please do contact Carol Kemp for assistance.
- 15. The show is being staffed entirely by volunteers who love cats so please bear with us, and if you're unsure about anything just ask. Just have fun, and enter as many times as you like.
